## ABSTRACT

In review of the book "Interpreting TRIPS: Globalisation of Intellectual Property Rights and Access to Medicine" authored by Professor Hiroko Yamane, this article further addresses the negative consequences on developing countries' access to proper medicine under the current TRIPS Agreement.
